

Solicitation for a Short-Term Consultancy for Genocide Education Project Posted May 24, 2017

Position: Short-Term Monitoring & Evaluation Educational Consultant

Duration: 7 months (part-time/ remote; one (1) overseas trip required)

Professional fee: \$6,000 lump sum

Minimum Qualifications: Undergraduate degree in education + at least 10 years work experience in the education sector (or Graduate degree in education + 2 years work experience) and professional competency in English language.

Preferred: Background in evaluating teachers; monitoring & evaluation of grants; or work experience in an educational institution of Southeast Asia.

Description: The Educational Monitoring & Evaluation Consultant will be responsible for providing a comprehensive evaluation of the effectiveness, efficiency, and sustainability of the Documentation Center of Cambodia's implementation of a teacher training and university lecturer training program in Cambodia. This program titled Khmer Rouge History Education through Teacher and University Lecturer Training is a proposed reparation project for Case 002 funded by EU. The consultant will provide comprehensive, written reports, which evaluate the Documentation Center of Cambodia's (DC-Cam) teacher/university lecturer training curriculum and program in Cambodia. The program is currently being implemented and will run through October 2017. The consultant will work with staff and other consultants. Most monitoring and evaluation work will be performed part-time and remotely; however, the consultant will be required to be in Cambodia for a minimum 10 days in July 2017 to attend a session of the university lecturer training program and conduct fieldwork at selected high schools in Kampong Cham and Battambang province to assess the impact of teacher training. Travel to Cambodia will be funded (economy class round-trip airfare, with accommodation).

Duties: Monitor and evaluate genocide education teacher and university lecturer training program between April and October 2017; Provide independent and comprehensive written reports (2) that evaluate all aspects of implementation of the program and its sustainability; Offer input and advice on refinement of metrics currently in-use; Assist director, staff, and other consultants in the implementation of the program when in-country.
