The Sleuk Rith Institute's School of Genocide, Conflict and Human Rights Studies is pleased to announce the eleventh event in its speaker series. "Indonesian killings of 1965-1966" will be presented by Fildza Nabila Avianti. Students as well as the general public are welcome to attend this event.

This presentation recalls a massacre in Indonesia during the 1965 and 1966, during which 500 thousands to 1 million people had been arrested and killed. It began as an anticommunist purge following a controversial coup by the army (30 September Movement) in Indonesia. The killing targeted communists, ethnic Chinese and alleged leftists, often at the instigation of the armed forces and government. This presentation also discusses about what has been done in Indonesia in order to deal with this past event.
