

## Youth Questions on the Khmer Rouge Tribunal

Student Outreach Project

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Translated by: Ser Sayana and Keo Dacil

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In the summers of 2005 and 2006 DC-Cam selected over 200 Cambodian university students eager to volunteer their vacation time to work for the Center. This outreach project was led by Noy Sophary in 2005 and by Ser Sayana in 2006. The students interviewed villagers regarding their experiences during the Cambodian genocide (1975-1979) which took place under the government of Democratic Kampuchea and gave out information about the Khmer Rouge tribunal to both interviewees and other villagers within the villagers they worked in. This outreach project was designed not only to incorporate Cambodia's youth into the tribunal outreach efforts of the Center, but also as a way for Cambodia's generation born after the genocide to learn about their parents' and country's history. This is a history that has a great impact upon present day Cambodia.

As a result of this experience, both villagers and students began to think seriously about the genocide and the tribunal. Many questions were raised by the student volunteers in regards to the genocide and the present tribunal. The Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (ECCC) officially began operating in summer of 2006. The Extraordinary Chambers is also referred to as the Khmer Rouge tribunal (KRT), which is the name that many students use when asking their questions. Below are the 216 questions that have been compiled and translated from Khmer into English. These questions come straight from the students and are based on their understanding of the Democratic Kampuchea and the tribunal in summer 2005 or summer 2006. When necessary, clarifications are given in brackets. The questions are arranged according to subject matter (A-L) and each question lists the names and ages of the students who asked them.
