## Voices of Genocide: Justice and the Khmer Rouge Famine

As part of its ongoing *Witnessing Justice Project*, the Documentation Center of Cambodia (DC-Cam) is pleased to announce the upcoming broadcast of a new community radio program: *Voices of Genocide: Justice and the Khmer Rouge Famine*. This ten-part series will explore the issues of justice and memory related to the deadly famine that gripped Cambodia during the Democratic Kampuchea (DK) period from 1975-1979. This famine, which killed up to one million people in slightly over three years, is often largely ignored during discussions of transitional justice in modern Cambodia, as the mass violence perpetrated by the Khmer Rouge regime fits neatly into existing understandings of international crimes. This is an unfortunate turn of events, as famine is a uniquely universal experience for survivors of the DK period, which can provide common ground for wide discussion of this dark period of Cambodian history.

The radio program will explore famine by providing a platform for victims to share their stories with a national audience, while also providing historical and legal insights into the DK period famine. Each episode will consist of an account of an individual person's experience of famine under the Khmer Rouge, followed by a discussion of international justice issues.

Through its *Voices of Genocide* program, DC-Cam hopes to facilitate discussion among Cambodians about an important aspect of their shared past. By addressing and understanding this dark shared history, Cambodians can further the ongoing process of national reconciliation and help move their country towards a future where human rights are fully realized for all.
