

GENOCIDE EDUCATION EDUCATION ON THE KHMER ROUGE HISTORY IN CAMBODIA (1975-1979)

WORK PLAN FOR 2017

• Nine (9) classroom forum at high schools in Phnom Penh:

January: Preah Yukunthor and Phsar Daem Thkov High School;

February: Boeng Prey and Prek Kampeus high school;

March: Wat Koh and Anuvoath high school;

May: Prek Thmey and Chamroeun Roath**June:** Prek Leap high school.

Three (3) commune teacher trainings in Kampong Cham, Kampong Thom and Prey Veng:

April: 100 participants will be selected from Stung Treng, Mondul Kiri, Rattanak Kiri, Kampong Cham, and Kratie.

May: 70-80 participants will be selected from Kampong Thom, Kampong Chhnang and Siem Reap.

October: 70-80 participants will be selected from Prey Veng and Svay Rieng.

Six (6) pre-service teacher trainings:

February to May: Six pre-service teachers training will be conducted at six regional teacher training center in Cambodia. There will be approximately 300 pre-service teachers will attend the training.

Genocide Education Memorials:

4 slogans will be installed in 4 high schools. See below schedule:

June: One high school in Prey Veng province.

July: One high school in Banteay Meanchey province.

October: One high school in Trapeang Prasat high school in Otdar Meanchey.

November: One high School in Kep.

Village History:

20-50 teachers who attended the training in Battambang will be selected to be village historian by training that will be responsible for writing their own histories from the village.

20-50 stories will be collected from the teachers.

1 or 2 training will be conducted to train teachers how to write the history.

1 workshop will be conducted to evaluate the writings from teachers.
